*Final Announcement*

Dear Sir/Madam,

Pursuant to the first announcement dated June 2, 2014, we are pleased to inform you that the International Co-operative Alliance – Asia and Pacific Committee on Youth Co-operation (ICYC) will hold its 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting on 17 September 2014, during the 11<sup>th</sup> Regional Assembly of the International Co-operative Alliance – Asia and Pacific (ICA-AP) scheduled from 15-20 September 2014 at Bali International Convention Centre in Bali, Indonesia.

The ICYC met in Buldana, India on 19 July 2013 for its 6<sup>th</sup> Meeting and decided on a path of action, adopted the committee constitution and elected a new board. Besides its activities and online meetings, the ICYC represented the youth co-operative movement at the World Conference on Youth 2014 held from 6-10 May, 2014 at Colombo, Sri Lanka. The theme of the conference was, “Mainstreaming Youth in the Post-2015 Agenda.” The Colombo Declaration adopted on 10 May 2014 and to be tabled at the 69<sup>th</sup> Session of the UN General Assembly scheduled to open on 16 September, 2014 seeks to promote co-operatives as an alternative business model in achieving its goal of mainstreaming youth in the post 2015 global agenda. The declaration reads as following in its 27<sup>th</sup> Paragraph,

*“27. Create an enabling business environment and multi-stakeholder partnerships, including between developing and developed countries that are environmentally sustainable to boost entrepreneurship, including start-ups and apprenticeship for youth and alternative models of enterprise such as co-operatives and intra-regional business incubators with focus on young women and young persons living with disabilities”.*

The 7<sup>th</sup> ICYC Meeting at Bali will aim to gather members as well as observers from the co-operative movement who would be participating at the 11<sup>th</sup> Regional Assembly. The agenda for 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting is based on the theme, ‘Financial Literacy for Youth’ and the committee shall seek to create action oriented programmes toward training and educating youth across the region on matters related to finance including thrift and credit. This is to focus the attention of co-operatives in creating entrepreneurs and employments among youth. The report of ICYC meeting as well its activities will be presented by the ICYC chairperson to the Regional Assembly on 19 September, 2014.

Please find enclosed the draft program of the 7<sup>th</sup> ICYC Meeting.

We look forward to seeing in Bali!
